Be sure to send in warm clothes for your child to play outside! All children should have mittens, snow pants, boots, a hat and a winter coat. Fresh air is wonderful for the children and we go outside each day unless the wind chill is 20 degrees or below. We also travel back to the farm... even in the winter! There's a great mini hill for sledding on... and besides, the animals get lonely! In the event that it is too cold to play outside the children are able to play in our basements.

FOR THE HEALTH OF OUR CHILDREN & STAFF

Please check your child daily for signs and symptoms for illness. If your child has had a fever, diarrhea, vomiting, or discharge from eyes, they need to remain at home until they have been free from these symptoms for 24 hours without taking medication. If a child is sent home from school, they may not return the next day. If they are symptom free after 24 hours without medication, then they may return. If you have to give your child medication to prevent a fever before coming to school, then they should not be in school.

All cots, tables, chairs, and toys are sanitized daily to prevent the spread of germs at school. Children and teachers wash their hands continuously through the day to prevent the spread of germs.

REAL LIFE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

It's already time to start thinking about this Summer and next Fall!

Registration for this Summer and the School year of 2026/2027 will begin on February 1st, 2026 for current families. Registration for new families will open on February 14, 2026.

When Registration opens on February 1st, there will be three different programs we will offer for your children. At this time, you will also be able to enroll older siblings (6-14 years) in our Summer Camp Program on the Farm and/or younger siblings (2.5 years-kindergarten age) in our Junior Camp or School Year Programs. The programs Real Life offers are as follows...

- **JUNIOR CAMP SUMMER PROGRAM** (ages 2.5 through Kindergarten). This program is housed in the Nursery School. Children travel back to the farm with their classrooms each day.
- **FARM SUMMER CAMP** (ages 6 through 14 years). This program is housed on the farm. Children will be on the farm for the entire day. The Farm Camp website is reallifefarm.com.
- **SCHOOL YEAR OF 2026/2027**- Little Lambs (2.5-3 yrs) Preschool Pals (3-4 yrs), Pre-Kindergarten (4-5 yrs), and Kindergarten (children turning 5 by December 1st).

Children who are currently in Kindergarten are eligible to enroll in our "Farm Summer Camp" or remain in our "Junior Camp Program." Children who are currently in the Little Lambs, Preschool Pals, or Kindergarten Readiness programs are eligible to enroll in our "Junior Camp" summer program which is housed out of the nursery school building and of course includes daily visits back to the farm!

Registration forms can be found through our online Parent Portal. To access the Parent Portal, go to our website at reallifenurseryschool.com and click the link on the Menu Bar that says Parent Portal. Here you can read more about each program Real Life offers.

- At the top of the website you will see a tab that says "Parent Portal."
- Click on the "RLNS Parent Portal" Tab and you will see the forms for our Summer Camp Programs and our School Year of 2026/27.
- If you are registering your child for both Summer and next school year, both Registration forms MUST be filled out.
- Once you complete your forms online, all forms MUST BE PRINTED and BROUGHT INTO THE SCHOOL IN ORDER TO COMPLETE REGISTRATION. Filling out forms online only WILL NOT hold your spot in our Programs.
- If you are registering a child for the Farm Summer Camp, Registration forms DO NOT need be printed. Registration for this program is online only.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL FORMS FOR JUNIOR CAMP AND THE 2026/27 SCHOOL YEAR MUST TO BE PRINTED OFF AND RETURNED TO THE SCHOOL TO HOLD YOUR CHILD'S SPOT. REGISTERING ONLINE ONLY WILL NOT HOLD YOUR CHILD'S PLACE. WE OPERATE ON A "FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS."

All of our school families have a PRIORITY REGISTRATION from February 1st through February 13th. Please know that waiting to register until after February 14th could result in your child being placed on a WAIT LIST.
